CALIBRATION INSTRUCTIONS: To provide proper distribution, calibrate spreader before application. For 4.0 pounds of product (or x pound of product) per 1,000 square feet (or per acre) of turfgrass: Check your spreader on 250 square feet (or x square feet) and adjust to apply at the rate of 1 pound of product (or x pounds of product) per 250 square feet (or x square feet).
