Labeling:

1. The signal word is "Danger".
2. The Precautionary Statements should read:

"Corrosive: Cause irreversible eye damage. May be fatal, if inhaled. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not breathe dust, vapor or spray mist. Wear goggles, face shield or safety glasses. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse".

3. The Statements of Practical Treatment should read:

"If in eyes: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention".

"If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention".

"If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists".

"If swallowed: Drink promptly large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Note to physician: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Get medical attention".

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For formulation into end-use products intended for disinfectants, sanitizers, fungicides, bactericides and algacides for pools, spas, hot tubs, industrial recirculating water cooling towers, air washers and evaporative condensers, sewage treatment food contact surfaces, laundry and egg sanitizing. Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registration of their formulated products.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool dry well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water to dissolve all material before discarding. Securely wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
