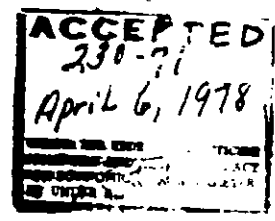
Sodium Dichloroisocyanurate Dihydrate 100%

(Contains 55% Available Chlorine Minimum)

Do not get in eyes or on the skin.
