BROWN ROT: Peaches, Nectarines, Cherries, Plums—Use 5 pounds to 100 gallons of water.

LEAF SPOT: Cherries, Plums—Use 5 pounds to 100 gallons of water.

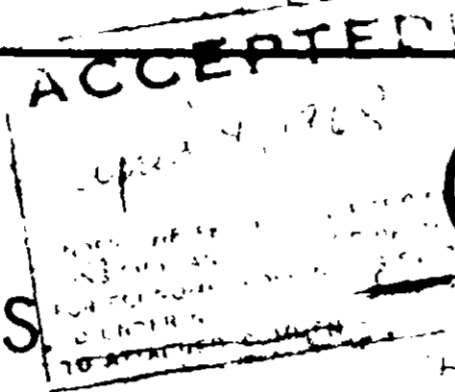
POWDERY MILDEW: Apples—Use 5 to 10 pounds to each 100 gallons of diluted spray. Grapes, Currants, Roses, Dahlias, Peaches, Nectarines—Use 5 pounds to 100 gallons of water. Strawberries—Use 5 lbs per 100 gal water or 4 to 6 lbs per acre.

RED SPIDER AND RUST MITES: Deciduous and Citrus Trees—Use 5 pounds of FLOTOX Wettable Sulfur and 1½ gallons of ORTHO Lime Sulfur Solution to make 100 gallons of diluted spray. Apply at first appearance of the pest or several days later. See spray directions.

SCAB: Apples and Pears—Use 5 to 10 pounds FLOTOX Wettable Sulfur to each 100 gallons of diluted spray. Before using ORTHO DNE or ORTHO DNE Plus, use ORTHO Flowering Bee Beehive Mixture as protective treatment. Peaches—Use 5 pounds of FLOTOX Wettable Sulfur to each 100 gallons of water.

THRIPS: Citrus—Use 5 pounds FLOTOX Wettable Sulfur to each 100 gallons of water. Apply at first appearance of the pest or several days later. See spray directions.

TOMATO RUSSET MITE: Tomatoes—Use 5 pounds FLOTOX Wettable Sulfur to each 100 gallons of water. Apply at first appearance of the pest or several days later. See spray directions.
