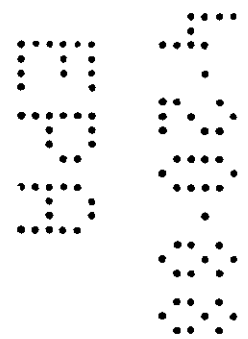

**As a Spray:** Mix 2 1/2 level Tablespoonfuls FLOTOX Garden Sulfur in a small amount of water, stir until a thick paste is formed. Then add water to make 1 gallon of mixture. Stir thoroughly. Make a new dilution for each use.

Do not use within 4 weeks of an oil spray treatment. Sulfur may cause injury to foliage if applied when temperature is exceedingly high. Do not make applications at this time.

PLANTS	PESTS	COMMENTS
ROSES	Powdery Mildew, Black Spot Combination spray to control Powdery Mildew, Black Spot, Aphids, Red Spider, Thrips, Leafhopper	Dust or spray every 7 to 10 days during growing season. 2 1/2 level Tablespoonfuls FLOTOX Garden Sulfur plus 1 Tablespoonful ISOTON Insect Spray per gallon water.
DAHLIAS CHRYSANTHEMUMS PEAS, BEANS	Powdery Mildew	Dust or spray every 7 to 10 days during growing season.
GRAPES	Powdery Mildew	Dust or spray when buds begin to break and at intervals of 2 weeks for at least 4 applications. If treatments may be necessary.
CHERRIES PEACHES, PLUMS PRUNES	Brown Rot	Spray or dust just before fruit starts to ripen.
APPLES PEARS	Scab	Spray when buds begin to swell and at 2 to 3 week intervals until 2 weeks after petal fall. During wet weather make additional treatments.
TOMATOES	Flycatcher  Red Spiders	Dust or spray when fruit begins to set to clean up early infestations. Repeat treatments as necessary. Do not apply sulfur on tomatoes within 40 days of harvest if they are to be stored in metal containers. Dust or spray when buds appear. Repeat if necessary.
CAMELIAS AZALEAS RHODODENDRONS HEATHER and many other acid-loving plants PREPARED LAWNSOIL		<b>SOIL CORRECTIVE:</b> Apply approximately 1 1/2 level Tablespoonful per square yard of soil to sulfur around listed plants annually. <b>Heavy Adobe Soil:</b> Apply at same rate, preferably in fall. <b>Prepared New Lawn Soil:</b> Use for topsoil correction only. Do not use for surface correction.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

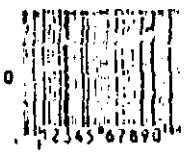
**STORAGE:** Keep pest side in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Store in a cool, dry place, preferably in a bucket in a garage area. Do not store diluted spray.

**DISPOSAL PRODUCT:** Partially filled canister may be disposed of by securely wrapping original canister in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER:** Do not use empty container. Discard canister in trash.
