BROWN APRICOT SCALE, BLACK SCALE: Prunes, Plums, Apricots, Cherries, Peaches, Nectarines, Almonds—Dormant Spray—Use 3 to 4 gallons of KLEENUP Flowable Emulsion to make 100 gallons of diluted spray. The addition of 1/2 to 1 pint parathion emulsive (4 lbs. per gal.) to 100 gallons water gives effective twig Echter control and greatly improves scale control. If winter rains have replenished moisture and bark of trees is noticeably damp, this spray should be applied in December or January.

OLIVE SCALE (Parlatoria Scale), OLEANDER SCALE and Other Scale Insects on Prunes, Plums, Apricots, Cherries, Peaches, Nectarines, Almonds—Dormant Spray—Use 1 1/2 to 1 pint parathion emulsive (4 lbs. per gal.) or 1 1/2 to 2 pounds of 25% wettable parathion with 4 gallons of KLEENUP Flowable Emulsion per 100 gallon spray.

SAN JOSE SCALE, ITALIAN PEAR SCALE, EGGS OF RED SPIDER MITES, EGGS OF APHIDS, HIBERNATING TWIG BORERS: Apples, Plums, Prunes, Cherries, Pears, Almonds, Apricots, Peaches, Nectarines—Dormant Spray—Use 1/2 to 1 pint parathion emulsive (4 lbs. per gal.) with 4 to 5 gallons KLEENUP Flowable Emulsion to make 100 gallons diluted spray. Apply in December or January when the buds are full of moisture.

LEAFROLLER EGGS: Apples, Pears and Prunes—Use 4 to 5 gallons of KLEENUP Flowable Emulsion with 1/2 to 1 pint parathion emulsive (4 lbs. per gal.) to make 100 gallon diluted spray. Apply when the buds swell but prior to bud-cracking.

MOSS AND LICHENS on Listed Crops—Dormant Spray—Use 2 to 4 gallons of KLEENUP Flowable Emulsion with 15 to 20 pounds of Spray, Liquid for each 100 gallons of diluted spray.

GRAPES: Mealybug—Use 2 pints of KLEENUP Flowable Emulsion plus 2 pints parathion emulsive (4 lbs. per gal.) per 100 gallons of spray. Apply in dormant.

WALNUTS: San Jose Scale, Frosted Scale and Other Soft Scales. Apply only when the buds are full of moisture. Use 1/2 to 1 pint parathion emulsive (4 lbs. per gal.) with 4 to 5 gallons of KLEENUP Flowable Emulsion to make 100 gallons diluted spray.

CAUTIONS: Do not spray Walnuts that lack good vigor, are heavily shaded, or are in poor health. Do not spray Walnuts that are heavily shaded or are in poor health.

MIXING: Always use KLEENUP Flowable Emulsion in a clean tank. Add one gallon of water to each gallon of concentrate. Check the product for settling. If settling occurs, shake the product thoroughly before use. Do not use if the product is solid, lumpy, or otherwise abnormal.
