## DIRECTIONS

**TERMINATIONS** First remove all wood debris and wood forms from around foundation. Around piers, pipes, of masonry bases and along poured concrete foundations, dig a trench 6 inches wide and 4 inches deep. For brick and concrete block foundations, dig a trench about 12 inches deep. If footing is more than 12 inches deep, make a Trench with a crowbar, pipe or rod about one foot apart, that extend from the trench bottom to the footing. Make holes closer in partially clay soils. Next, dig holes below the bottom of the footing (see 4 Tablespph). Use 12.9 or higher grade of water treated 21 inch steel soil trencher. Apply the solution to the trench at the rate of 1 gallon per 10 linear feet per foot of depth. Apply half the solution to the trench on a half the back fill soil. Likewise treat along the entire base of the foundation of crawl space buildings. The treatment is fast and easy with an ORTHO Lawn Sprayer or ORTHO Lawn and Garden Sprayer. For setting and "down soil" adjustment, fill the sprayer jar with 1 qt (32 fl oz) of ORTHO MGR 44 Chlorogenic Spray. Add 1/2 the spray to 1 pint of 1/2 inch steel trencher. Apply the mixture to the surface in heavy clay or much soils. Concrete treated in 1/2 inch steel trencher, and down soil to avoid contaminating water supplies. Be careful to read and follow the directions on all materials.

For raised porches, terraces, and entrance slabs, drill holes at one foot intervals, 6 inches from the foundation, and pour soil on into each hole. Penhollows. Slabs with heated floors set along heat pipes should be treated by professional pest control. In most cases, slabs are treated with barrier which is impractical to enter. Other critical areas may also require treatment (e.g., roof, exterior baseboards, etc.) but are not covered in this suggestion. Be careful not to puncture the plastic sheeting when returning soil to the trench. Do not treat structures that contain cisterns or wells.
