

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS 12pt

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

12pt DANGER

Methanol may be fatal or cause blindness if swallowed; harmful if absorbed through the skin. Vapor harmful. Causes irreversible eye damage. Avoid breathing spray mist or vapor. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

12pt STATEMENT OF EFFECTUAL TREATMENT

If swallowed, give a large amount of water to drink, make person vomit, and call a doctor. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. In case of eye contact, immediately wash eyes with fresh water for at least 15 minutes and see a doctor. For skin contact, remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If inhaled, remove person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

It mixes readily with water and stays in suspension without agitation during the transplanting operation. The use of ISOTOX Transplanter Solution in transplanting water establishes a zone of protection around the roots of newly set plants. This allows the roots to develop and the plants to become established.

DIRECTIONS

SPROUTS: BRUSSELS SPROUTS, CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER, BELL PEPPERS, CUCUMBERS, TOMATOES, CABBAGE MAGGOTS, 4 fl oz per 100 gal of transplanting water. Apply daily about 10 days prior to transplanting. Apply 200 to 250 gal of transplanting water per acre. Add ISOTOX Transplanter Solution directly to the tank with a strong water supply.

TRANSPLANTING: CABBAGE, CUCUMBERS, 1/2 pt per 50 gal of transplanting water. Apply 200 to 250 gal per acre.

SPROUTS: BRUSSELS SPROUTS, CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER, BELL PEPPERS, CUCUMBERS, TOMATOES, CABBAGE MAGGOTS, 4 fl oz per 100 gal of transplanting water. Apply daily about 10 days prior to transplanting. Apply 200 to 250 gal per acre.

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NOTE: Do not apply to root crops. Do not use in soil to be planted to root crops within 1 year except for Sweet Potato transplants. Do not use on foliage of white or sweet potatoes.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
