PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Refillable Duster: Remove the cap and refill.

ORTHO Rose & Floral Dust Formula IV is especially formulated for the control of insects and diseases. Do not apply to crops to be used for food or feed.

DIRECTIONS: To apply just a few drops, tap bottom lightly and shake before first use. **DUST AT ANY ANGLE** For best results, dust in early morning or evening when the temperature is low and the air is still. Apply dust to all exposed parts of plants, especially undersides of leaves and lower leaf surfaces.

For Insect Control: Apply when insects first appear and repeat at 5 to 10 day intervals as necessary.

For Disease Control: Start program of dusting as soon as foliage appears. Repeat at 1 to 2 week intervals for best protection.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

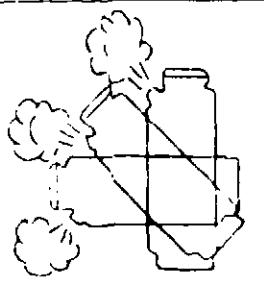

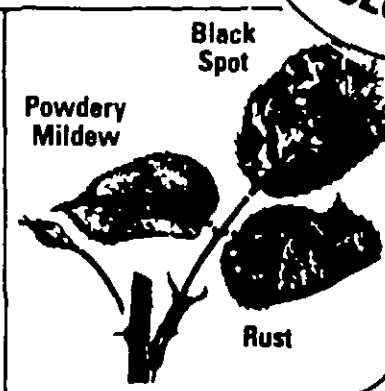
