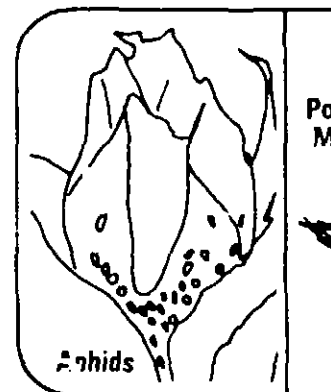

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Wear chemical resistant gloves when using outdoors. Wear long pants and long-sleeved shirt and apply with the wind to your back. Wash nondisposable gloves thoroughly with soap and water before removing. Clothing worn while handling this product must be laundered separately from other clothing before reusing.

ORTHO Rose & Floral Dust Formula IV may be used as a dust or spray. For best results, dust or spray in early morning or late evening when temperature is low and air is still. Apply so all exposed parts of plants are contacted, especially upper and lower leaf surfaces. Do not apply to crops to be used for food or feed.

As a Spray: Mix 3 to 4 Teaspoonfuls in a little water to make a thin paste, add to 1 gallon water and agitate during application. Make new dilution for each use.

As a Dust: Apply a light film of dust to all parts of plant. Do not over-apply.

For Insect Control: Apply when insects first appear and repeat at 5 to 10 day intervals or as necessary.

For Disease Control: Start program of dusting as soon as foliage appears. Repeat at 1 to 2 week intervals for best protection.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Store in a cool, dry place, preferably in a locked storage area. Do not store diluted spray.

DISPOSAL: PRODUCT—Partially filled canister may be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER**—Do not reuse canister. Discard canister in trash.
