



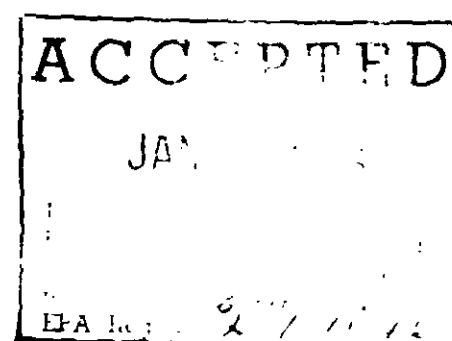

ORTHO Soybean Seed Protectant is a specifically designed formulation of ORTHOCIDE for the treatment of soybean and peanut seeds. Seed protection is afforded sound and/or mechanically injured seed against seed and soil-borne diseases such as seedling blight, damping off and seed decay organisms at planting time.

Designed specifically for seed protection at planting time, ORTHO Soybean Seed Protectant requires no additional seed handling to have seed treated, thus lowers the percentage of cracked or "split" seed planted. At recommended dosage rates this product assures adequate seed coverage and allows any excess to flow down with the seed into the seed furrow thus affording maximum protection. Can be used on previously treated seed.

DIRECTIONS

(One level scoop holds approximately 4 ounces of product.) For improved mixing of product with seed, the following procedure is suggested: Fill planter box only half full of seed, add half the required amount of ORTHO Soybean Seed Protectant and mix thoroughly with a stick. Then put remainder of seed in planter box and add the rest of the required ORTHO Soybean Seed Protectant, mixing thoroughly again. Good results are also obtained by premixing seed with ORTHO Soybean Seed Pro-

tectant in a suitable container, then pouring treated seed into planter box.

SOYBEANS: Use ORTHO Soybean Seed Protectant as a planter box treatment at the rate of 4 ounces per bushel or 7 ounces to 100 lbs. seed.

PEANUTS: Use ORTHO Soybean Seed Protectant as a planter box treatment at the rate of 2 to 4 ozs. per bushel or 4 to 6 ounces per 100 lbs. seed.

CAUTION: May cause eye irritation. Do not get in eyes. Avoid contact with skin. Avoid inhalation of dust. In case of eye contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of clear water.
