DIRECTIONS

CITRUS: Florida Red Scale, Purple Scale, Snow Scale, White Flies (intermediate forms) and Spider Mites, Greasy Spot — Use 5 gals. of FLORIDA VOLCK Soluble Spray to 500 gals. water for .97% strength. For Spider Mite Control Only—Dosage

Harmful if swallowed. Oil sprays and sulfur or lime sulfur combinations are unsafe foliage applications. Treatment with either should not be made until the effects of the other have disappeared. There should be an interval of 3 to 4 weeks between such treatments. The spray tank must be free of any sulfur residue before using FLORIDA VOLCK Soluble Spray. Avoid spraying when the temperature is excessively high (over 90° F.). Avoid spraying trees that are suffering from lack of moisture.

may be reduced to 3 gals. to 500 gals. water for .57% strength. The grower is advised to consult his State Agricultural Experiment Station as to the best time to spray for any particular pest. For Greasy Spot control, applications should be made within 1 month after the expansion of late spring and early summer growth flushes. In using any contact spray, careful and thorough coverage is essential for effective control.

MIXING: With agitator running, start filling spray tank with water. Add the desired dry spray materials. The FLORIDA VOLCK Soluble Spray should be added when tank is about one-half full.
