





HOW TO APPLY

- Wearing household latex or rubber gloves, use a dust applicator such as a shaker can, bulbous duster, or rotary duster. Dust lightly to cover ~~both~~ upper and lower leaf surfaces with a thin, even film of dust.
- Apply when air is calm to avoid drift and contact with eyes and skin.
- Start applying at the farthest corner of the treatment area and work backward to avoid contact with dusted surfaces. Allow dust to settle in treated areas before reentering.
- For plants above chest height, consider using ORTHO Sevin Liquid. ~~a liquid carbaryl product.~~

WHEN TO APPLY

- Apply dust at first signs of insects/pests.
- Dust in early morning or late evening when temperature is low.
- Apply/Repeat/Reapply as necessary, but not more often than once weekly.
- **BLUEBERRIES:** Apply 3 weeks before harvest and repeat/reapply 10 days later or as necessary.
- **CORN:** For insects attacking silks and ears apply when first silks appear and continue until silks begin to dry. Three or more applications may be required



depending on severity of infestation.

- **CUCUMBERS, MELONS, PUMPKINS, SQUASH:** Avoid excessive applications. Some leaf injury may occur if treatments are made when tender foliage is wet or in the presence of prolonged high humidity.

ON DOGS AND/& CATS (To control Ticks and/& Fleas)

HOW TO APPLY

Use product only outside or in a well-ventilated area. Wearing household latex or rubber gloves, lightly dust entire animal, avoiding pet's eyes, nose, mouth and genital areas. Rub or brush pet's hair to work dust down to the skin. Dust bedding and doghouse lightly using a shaker can or other dust applicator.

WHEN TO APPLY

Apply/Repeat/Reapply as necessary to dogs and cats but not more often than once a month. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, medicated, pregnant or nursing dogs or cats. Do not use on animals under 12 weeks of age.

Sensitivities may occur after using any pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.




