CELERY: Pink Rot, Gummy-Off-(Field)-13 lbs. per acre. -25 to 30 lbs. per acre. Apply when oil scab is present. Repeat as necessary.

GRAPES: Botrytis Rot (Bunch Rot), Powdery Mildew, Storage Rot-33 lbs. per acre. Make 2 to 3 applications before bloom and 1 application just after bloom. Make up to 3 cover applications before harvest.

PEACHES: Brown Rot, Storage Rot, Powdery Mildew, Peach Scab-33 lbs. per acre. Make 2 to 3 applications. Repeat at petal fall and 3 to 4 covers before preharvest application where necessary.

PLUMS: Brown Rot, Storage Rot, Powdery Mildew-33 lbs. per acre. Make 2 to 3 prebloom applications at petal fall and 3 to 4 covers as necessary. Repeat application where necessary.

ROSES (Field): Rust, Powdery Mildew-35 lbs. per acre. Apply to give even coverage of upper and lower surfaces. Repeat at regular intervals to maintain control.

STRAWBERRIES: Botrytis Rot, Powdery Mildew-33 lbs. per acre. Immediately after picking. Repeat application where necessary.

Do not apply under conditions involving heavy rain or other plantings that may be rendered unfit for sale, use or consumption.

COMPATIBILITY: Do not use this product or other pesticides in conjunction with oil sprays.
