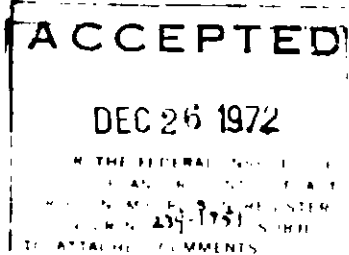

This product is formulated for application by ground or air equipment. Begin applications at first sign of insects. Repeat as necessary. Apply for contact and thorough coverage for control of insects.

GRAPES: Spider Mites, Leafhoppers—35 pounds per acre.
