### **DIRECTIONS**

ORTHO Kleen Stock DV Concentrate may be applied by dip or spray to control ticks, lice, horn fly and sheep ked on ~~Beef Cattle, Sheep, Goats, Horses and Hogs and to aid in screwworm control.~~ Animals may be treated any time before slaughter. Do not use on dairy animals. Do not dip under 3 months of age.

**CATTLE (except Dairy Cattle), HORSES: Lice, Ticks, Ear Ticks, Horn Flies**—1 pint to 25 gals. water. Mix well for a creamy emulsion. Use strong spray to penetrate the skin, or dip thoroughly. Use 2 quarts for a grown cow or horse and proportionally less for smaller animals. Do not overdose young animals. **Ticks**—Repeat applications not more than once every 2 weeks. **Hornfly**—Repeat at 2 to 3-week intervals. **Lice**—Repeat only when necessary.

**SHEEP, GOATS (except Dairy Goats): Lice, Sheep Ticks (Keds), Wool Maggots**—1 pint to 25 gals. water. Mix well and spray or dip animals thoroughly. Keep dipping vat well stirred. ~~Post shearing treatment may also aid in control of screwworm.~~

**HOGS: Lice**—1 pint to 25 gals. water. Mix thoroughly and spray to thoroughly wet skin.

**BEEF CATTLE: Horn Flies—POUR-ON TREATMENT**—1 pint to 4<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> gals. water. Apply 1 quart dilute material along backline of animals. Do not repeat application within 30 days.

**BACK RUBBERS: As an Aid in Control of Lice and Hornflies on Beef Cattle**—1 pint to 9 quarts of backrubber oil. Charge backrubber as necessary and as the occasion requires. Do not apply this dilution to animals.
