DIRECTIONS

BEANS: Lygus Bugs, Stink Bugs, Mexican Bean Beetle—20 lbs. per acre. Apply thoroughly when insects appear and repeat every 7 to 10 days as necessary. Do not apply within 4 days of harvest.

COTTON: Armyworms, Salt-Marsh Caterpillar, Bollworms, Lygus, Fleahoppers, Aphids, Cotton Leaf Perforator—25 lbs. per acre. Apply as insects appear. Repeat at 7 to 10-day intervals while pests persist. Do not apply within 4 days of hand-picking.

GRAPES: Leafhoppers, Leafrollers—20 lbs. per acre. Apply thoroughly when insects appear and repeat as necessary. Do not apply within 4 days of harvest.

PEACHES: Mites, Oriental Fruit Moth, Twig Borer—25 lbs. per acre. Do not apply within 4 days of harvest.

TOMATOES: Aphids, Drosophila, Tomato Fruitworm, Tomato Hornworm, Armyworms, Leafminers, Stink Bugs—25 to 40 lbs. per acre. Russett Mites—40 lbs. per acre. May be applied within 10 days of harvest on tomatoes.
