

DIRECTIONS: MEASURING CUP ENCLOSED

SOYBEANS: Use ORTHO Soybean Seed Protectant (MO) as a planter box treatment at the rate of 4 oz. per bushel or 7 oz. per 100 lbs. seed. When seed is planted at the rate of one bushel per acre, this will provide the needed ½ oz. of sodium molybdate per acre.
