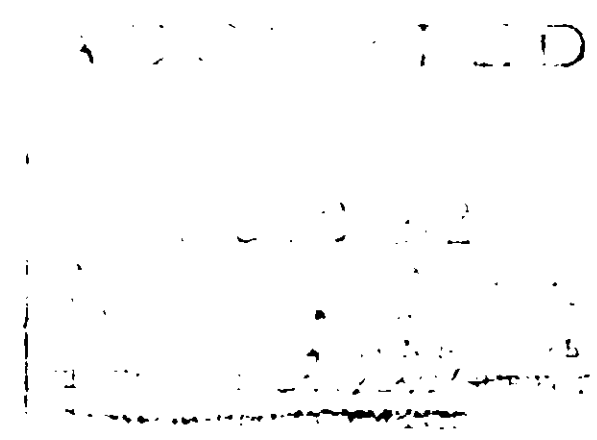

TOMATOES (Field): Fruit Flies (*Drosophila* sp.), Two-Spotted Mites, Aphids, Leafminers, Tomato Fruitworms, Hornworms, Colorado Potato Beetles, White Flies, Flea Beetles, Stink-bugs—33 lbs. per acre. Take up and burn at 6 to 7 day intervals. Do not apply within 10 days of harvest.
