DIRECTIONS: ORTHO Spot Weed & Grass Killer is formulated for "spot" application to individual weeds in lawns, foundations, driveways, walks, patios, and for edging grass around flower beds, trees, shrubs and perennial shrubs. 2. INVERT CAN HOLD AT ARM'S LENGTH AND POINT CAN AT WALL OR
3. FLOOR PRESS BUTTON DO NOT PRESS BUTTON WHEN CAN IS IN
4. RIGHT POSITION

3. Hold container close to weed (1 to 2 feet). Push down briefly on button when treating small weeds. For tall, rank growing weeds, thorough coverage is required to kill.

4 One application will kill most of the weeds listed. If certain perennial weeds (arrow) treat again as soon as regrowth is noticed.

5. When used to edge lawn grasses repeat application will be needed to maintain a neat appearance.

RESEEDING: Treated spots in lawn may be reseeded 24 hours after treatment. Remove dead vegetation, scratch the spot to provide a seedbed, spread seed, then tamp the area lightly.

NOTE: Since ORTHO Spot Weed & Grass Killer will brown any green vegetation that it comes in contact with, avoid spraying or splattering green stems and foliage when spraying weeds around flowers and shrubs and confine spray to undesirable grass and weeds when spot treating lawns. Spray will kill desirable grasses that are contacted.
