

DIRECTIONS

This material is especially formulated for potato seed piece treatment.

POTATO SEED PIECES: To Control Black Leg Seed Rot and Damp-Off, Verticillium Wilt and Brown-Eye Disease—Dust at 10 ounces per bushel of cut seed pieces. 1 lb. per 100 lbs. of cut seed pieces.

Apply in convenient container or by duster attachment over belt. Cut pieces should be treated within 6 hours of cutting. If planting is to be delayed more than 1 or 2 days the treated pieces should be stored for 2 to 3 days in open crates before bagging. Seed piece treatment only. Do not use treated seed pieces for food or feed purposes.
