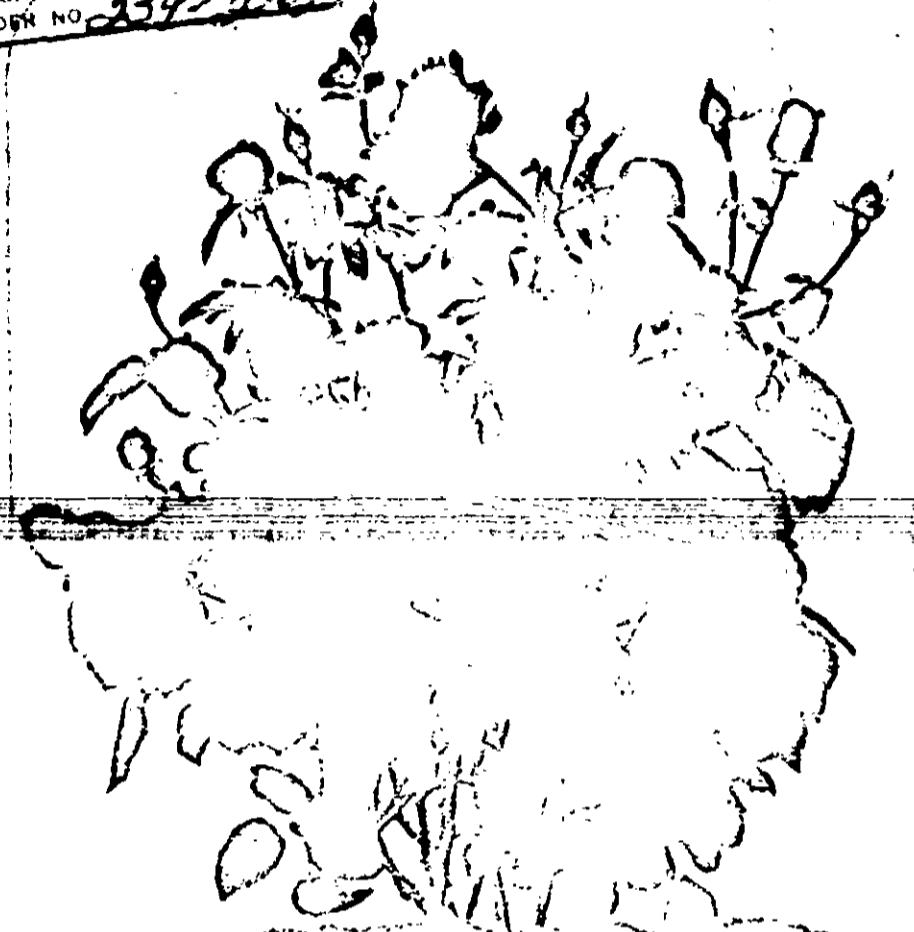

KEEP PESTICIDE IN ORIGINAL CONTAINER.

This 2-way product: (1) FEEDS roses, flowers and other plants for luxuriant growth and bloom, (2) PREVENTS BROADLEAF and GRASSY WEEDS* from getting started in planting beds. May be applied to trees, shrubs and most established flowers**. Do not apply to Ajuga, Myrtle, Pachysandra, and other ornamental ground-covers as injury may result.

DIRECTIONS: Apply anytime after flowers and plants are well established, at least 2-3 inches high. For best results, follow these directions carefully:



1. Before applying, remove all existing broadleaf and grassy weeds since product kills sprouting seeds, not established weeds.

2. Punch handy perforations under pull-tape on top for easy spreading, or pour from spout into smaller container for spreading.

3. Spread ORTHO ROSE & FLOWER WEED AND FEED evenly. Avoid missing small areas since weeds will grow in spots not covered. Working product into soil lightly gives maximum weed control and fertilizer activity.

4. Contents of this package covers 180 sq. ft. of soil area. A second application in 6 weeks will assure continued weed control.

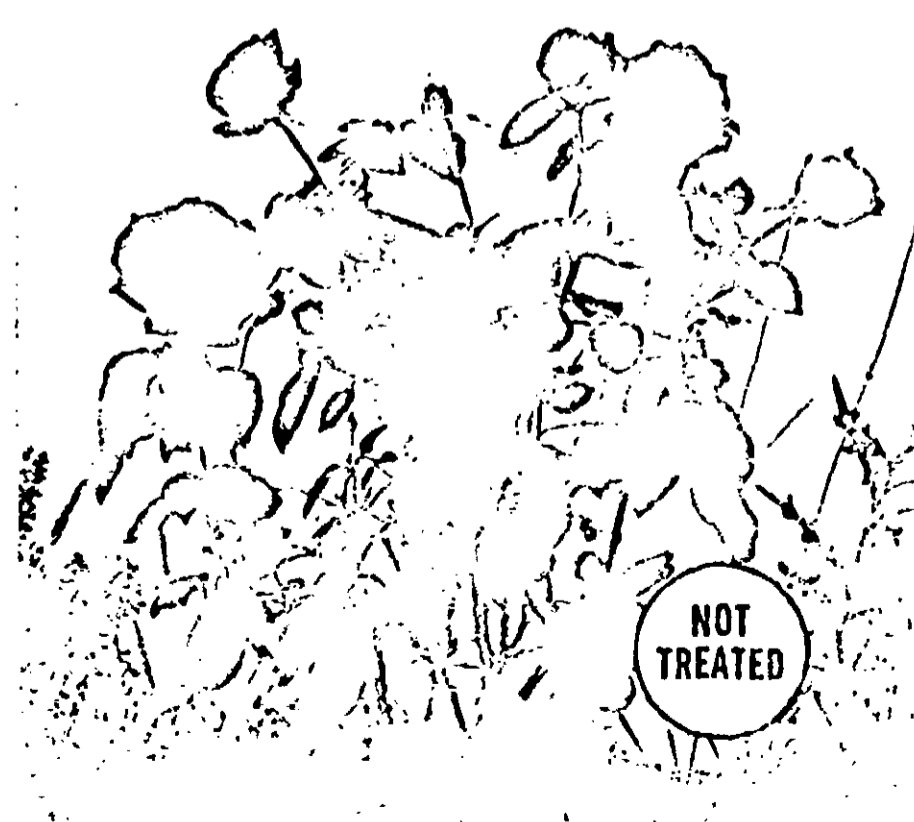
5. After application, sprinkle plants and shrubs lightly with water to remove any of the product from foliage.

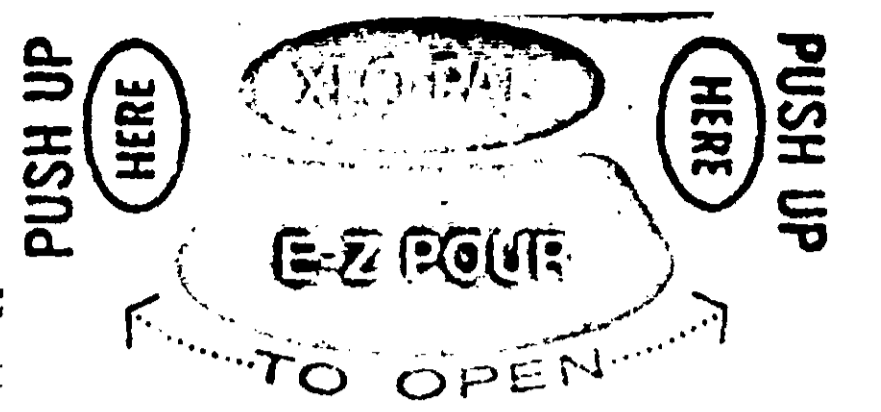

** Use around: Ageratum, Aster, Balsam, Calendula, California Poppy, Callionosis, Carnation, Cosmos, Dahlia, Forget-Me-Not, Four O'Clocks, Gaillardia, Gladiolus, Holly, Hock, Lobelia, Marigold, Morning Glory, Nasturtium, Periwinkle, Petunia, Roses, Shasta Daisy, Snapdragon, Sunflower, Sweet Alyssum, Sweet Pea, Zinnia.
