

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS
DANGER**

Causes irreversible eye damage and causes skin irritation. Can cause allergic skin reactions. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. PEANUTS: Use 5 oz. per 100 lbs. of seed. Apply with standard commercial treating machine designed for dust formulations and providing uniform coverage of treated seed.

Do not use treated seed for human consumption. Seeds treated with DIFOLATAN BOTRAN 35-35 Seed Protectant, sold or shipped as feed or foodstuffs, may be considered adulterated under state and federal laws. Treated seed should be labeled as follows: "TREATED SEED. DO NOT USE FOR FOOD, FEED OR OIL".
