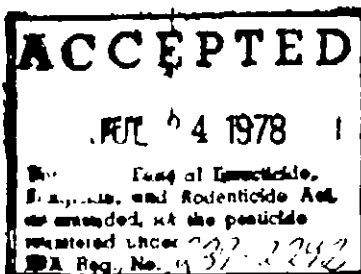

DIRECTIONS

WHEN TO USE

Make first application after cultivating and before weed seeds germinate (when roses have about 1" of new growth). Repeat every 6 weeks or 2 to 3 times each season. Do not apply additional fertilizer for 6 weeks following this treatment.

HOW TO USE

Remove all weeds before treating. Cultivate soil around plant. Apply ORTHO 3-WAY ROSE AND FLOWER CARE evenly at dosages given below. Work granules into top 1 inch of soil. Water thoroughly. Do not apply in planting holes.

ROSES (established or newly planted rose bushes)

Apply 4 oz. around each rose bush to cover a 9 sq. ft. (3' x 3') area.

ESTABLISHED BEDDING PLANTS, FLOWERS AND GLADIOLI

Apply 4 oz. to cover a 9 sq. ft. area (2 1/2 lbs. per 100 sq. ft. (5' x 20')). Do not use when planting seed.

ORNAMENTAL SHRUBS

Apply 4 oz. for each 9 sq. ft. (3' x 3') occupied by plant. **NOTE:** Applied as directed, this product will not harm beneficial or pollinating insects.
