



PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

Chemical may be fatal if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin and clothing. Do not breathe vapors or dust. Do not get in eyes, nose, or mouth. Wash thoroughly with soap and water if contact occurs. If swallowed, give oral dose of 1-2 PAM.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of eye contact, immediately wash eyes with water for 15 minutes. If swallowed, induce vomiting immediately. Remove clothing and wash thoroughly with soap and water. If contact occurs, wash skin with soap and water. If contact occurs, wash skin with soap and water. If contact occurs, wash skin with soap and water.

Note to Physicians: Emergency information call 414-233-3737. Nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea are common symptoms of acute poisoning. Atropine is the antidote. 2-PAM may also be given in conjunction with atropine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS

Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate into food or drink containers. Store in cool, dry place out of direct sunlight. Do not store or transport near feed or food.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL

CONTAINER DISPOSAL
