**DIRECTIONS**

This product is formulated for equipment.

**APRICOTS:** Fruit Decay (Brown Rot) acre. Apply 10 days and 1 day Apricots within 1 day of harvest.

**PEACHES, NECTARINES:** Brown Rot acre. Make 2 to 3 prebloom applications 3 to 4 covers as necessary. Fruit —50 lbs. per acre. Apply 1E day of harvest. Do not apply within 1 day of nectarines.

**SWEET CHERRIES:** Cherry Leaf Spot acre. Apply at budbreak, blossom, and at 10 to 14 day intervals. Fruit 50 lbs. per acre. Apply 10 days before harvest. Do not apply to Cherries within 1 day of harvest.

**ORNAMENTAL CROPS**

**ROSES, HYDRANGEA:** Blight (Blight) Apply prior to shipment or storage. Store in dust storage area and all cones. Do not apply during long storage periods.

**CHRYSANTHEMUM, GERANIUM,** per acre. Apply at first sign of blight on upper and lower leaf surfaces. Repeat applications as needed.

**GLADIOLUS:** Dry Rot (Stromatolite) linear feet of furrow. Dust into furrow and soil surrounds corms. Foliage—3 to 4 times per acre. Apply 10 days before spikes after harvest and before storage.

Do not apply under conditions of rain, fog or other plantings that would be thereof rendered unfit for sale, use or handling.

**COMPATIBILITY:** Do not use this product in conjunction with other fungicides.
