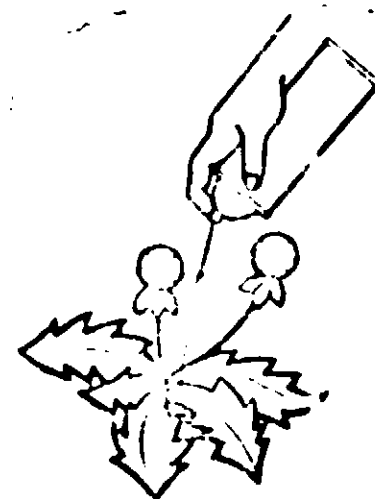

ORTHO WEED-B-GON Jet Weeder is formulated for "spot" application to individual weeds. DIRECTIONS

1. Shake can just before using and occasionally during use.
2. Invert can, hold at arm's length, and point can at weed as you press button. Do not press button when can is in upright position.
3. Stand close to weed (1 to 2 feet) with can aimed at weed and away from face.
4. Push down briefly on button. Spray to cover center of weed, do not over spray. The spray's foaming action will make it easy for you to see coverage.
5. One application will kill most weeds listed. If certain tough weeds are not dead within 3 weeks, repeat application.

NOTE: Be careful when treating weeds not to spray surrounding desirable grasses unless the browning of these grasses can be tolerated. Also avoid spraying or spattering of nearby flowers and other desirable plants.

CAUTION: Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash hands after use. Clover, Dichondra and certain grasses, such as Bentgrass, St. Augustine or Carpet grass are sensitive to herbicides and may be injured by use of this product. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides. Do not use or store near fire or open flame.
