WEED-B-GON M is an amine formulation containing 2,4-D and MCPP. It is for effective control of lawn weeds and will not harm lawn grasses when used according to directions. Do not store diluted spray. Make new dilution for each use.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON LAWNS

For control of Dandelions, Chickweed, Plantains, Clover and the other listed weeds, apply WEED-B-GON M any time weeds are actively growing. Weeds such as wild garlic and wild onions should be sprayed when they appear in late fall and again in early spring.

### HOW TO USE

For best results, use an ORTHO garden hose sprayer. Refer to table for recommended dilution. If lawn needs watering, water thoroughly before application. **Do not water for 48 hours after application.** Spray entire lawn, wetting weeds and lawn grasses; do not overspray. Spray when air is calm to avoid spray drift that might injure desirable ornamental plants. Do not apply when temperatures are expected to exceed 85 F for 24 hours.

**NEWLY SEEDD LAWNS** may be treated after they have been mowed at least 3 times. **BENT GRASSES, RED FESCUE, CENTIPEDE AND CARPET GRASS:** Use one-half recommended rate (2 teaspoonfuls per gal. water). Temporary injury may occur. Make 2 applications 10 days apart. Do not apply to Dichondra, Lippia, St. Augustine and Clover lawns.



**KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.**

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. For eyes, get medical attention. Wash hands after use. **Avoid spray contact or drift to susceptible plants as this product may injure flowers, shrubs, garden vegetables, fruit trees and other crops.** Coarse sprays are less likely to drift. When container is empty, immediately wash thoroughly and destroy. Never re-use. Do not store near feed, foodstuffs, fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides. When ORTHO Sprayer is used and rinsed thoroughly as directed on sprayer jar **immediately after applying WEED-B-GON M** it can be used to apply insecticides, fungicides and liquid fertilizers to ornamental plants.

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes.

### DILUTION TABLE

AREA TO TREAT	WATER TO USE	AMOUNT OF WEED-B-GON M TO USE
200 sq. ft.	1 gallon	4 teaspoonfuls
1200 sq. ft.	6 gallons	8 Tablespoonfuls (4 ounces)
1600 sq. ft.	8 gallons	11 Tablespoonfuls (5 1/2 ounces)
3000 sq. ft.	15 gallons	1 1/4 cups (10 ounces)

Use one-half of this rate for Bent Grasses, Red Fescue, Centipede and Carpet Grass.

**HARDY WEEDS:** For hardy weeds such as sheep sorrel, dock, thistle and morning-glory in lawns and other areas, repeat application in 2 to 3 weeks if necessary.

**IMPORTANT:** Do not use this product for controlling weeds in flower or vegetable beds or around shrubs or ornamental plantings. Do not reseed for 3 to 4 weeks after use.
