DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON LAWNS: For control of Dandelions, Chickweed, Plantains, Clover and the other listed weeds, apply WEED-B-GON M any time weeds are actively growing. Weeds such as wild garlic and wild onions should be sprayed when they appear in late fall and again in early spring.

HOW TO USE: For best results, use an ORTHO garden hose sprayer. Refer to table for recommended dilution. If lawn needs watering, water thoroughly before application. **Do not water for 48 hours after application.** Spray entire lawn, wetting weeds and lawn grasses. Do not overspray. HARDY WEEDS: For hardy weeds such as sheep sorrel, dock, thistle and morningglory in lawns and other areas, repeat application in 2 to 3 weeks if necessary.

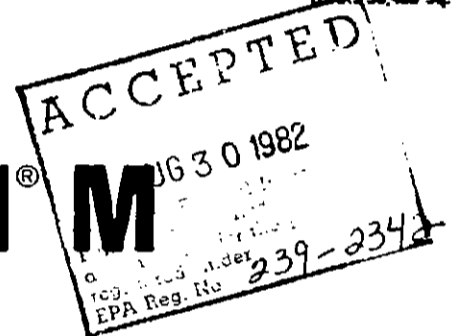
