PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Corrosive to eyes. Causes eye damage. Do not get in eyes. Wear goggles or face shield when handling concentrate. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. In case of eye contact, immediately flush eyes with fresh water for 15 minutes and get medical attention. If swallowed, promptly drink a large quantity of water and induce vomiting. Get medical attention immediately. In case of skin contact, wash skin with plenty of soap and water. This product and the label are the property of Chevron Chemical Company, consistent with its labeling.

READ ENTIRE LABEL USE STRICTLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH LABEL PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS AND DIRECTIONS

WEED-B-GON M is a selective herbicide for use on lawns. It is for effective control of lawn weeds and is safe for lawn grasses when used in accordance with directions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON LAWNS: For control of the weeds listed on the Weeds Planting Cover and the other listed weeds on WEED-B-GON M, apply the weed killer to your lawn by spraying weeds such as wild garlic and wild onion. Do not spray when the grass is wet, or after a heavy rain, and apply in early spring.

HOW TO USE: For best results, use ORTHO Sprayer for application. Refer to label for recommended dilution. Always wear protective clothing when using this product. **Do not water for 48 hours after application.** Do not water lawn with any other lawn care product for 24 hours after application. When it is time to water, spray with water. Do not water lawn until the weeds are dead. Do not apply when temperatures are expected to be below 50°F or above 90°F. Do not apply to newly seeded lawns.

NEWLY SEEDD LAWNS: Do not water newly seeded lawns for at least 3 times. **BENT, BERMUDA, RED FESCUE, CENTIFEDE AND CARPETGRASSES:** Do not water newly seeded lawns for at least 24 hours after application. Do not apply to Dichondra, Lippia or Agave and other plants.

HARDY WEEDS: For control of hardy weeds, apply to lawn and other areas repeatedly. Do not water lawn for 48 hours after application.

IMPORTANT: Do not use this product for controlling weeds in flower or vegetable beds or around shrubs or ornamental plantings. Do not reseed for 3 to 4 weeks after use.

***Use one half of this rate for Bent, Bermuda, Red Fescue, Centipede and Carpetgrasses.

Avoid spray contact or drift to susceptible plants as this product may injure flowers, shrubs, garden vegetables, fruit trees and other crops. Coarse sprays are less likely to drift. When ORTHO Sprayer is used and rinsed thoroughly as directed on sprayer jar immediately after applying WEED-B-GON M it can be used to apply insecticides, fungicides and liquid fertilizers to ornamental plants.

TO PREPARE REFILL FOR WEED-B-GON WEED KILLER, EPA REG. NO. 239-2499: Measure 2 1/2 teaspoonfuls of WEED-B-GON M into the empty container of WEED-B-GON WEED KILLER and then fill to the 20 oz. mark with tap water. Use according to the directions and precautions on the applicator bottle.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not store near feed, foodstuffs, fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides. Store in a cool, dry place, preferably in a locked storage area. Do not store diluted spray.

DISPOSAL PRODUCT: Partially filled can may be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER:** Do not reuse empty can. Rinse thoroughly with water and put in trash.
