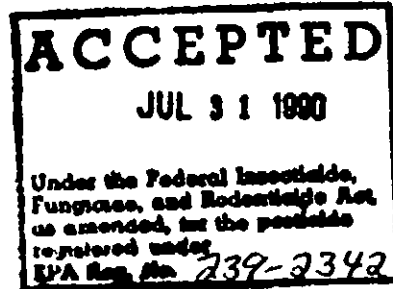

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Corrosive to eyes. Causes eye damage. Do not get in eyes. Wear goggles or face shield when mixing and applying. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Wear long pants, long sleeved shirt and chemical resistant gloves when applying product. **Mixing:** When mixing or applying this product, wear chemical resistant gloves. Wash nondisposable gloves thoroughly with soap and water before removing. Remove contaminated clothing and launder separately before reuse. Thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water after handling. Keep children and animals off treated areas until spray is dry. **STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:** In case of eye contact, immediately flush eyes with fresh water for 15 minutes and get medical attention. If swallowed, give plenty of water or milk to drink and telephone for medical advice. **DO NOT** make person vomit unless directed to do so by medical personnel. If medical advice cannot be obtained, then take person and product container to the nearest medical emergency treatment center or hospital. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Drift or runoff may adversely affect aquatic invertebrates and nontarget plants. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes, and potholes). Exercise caution when mixing and disposing of waste as groundwater contamination may result from careless handling or spills. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

READ ENTIRE LABEL. USE STRICTLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH LABEL PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS AND DIRECTIONS.

WEED-B-GON M is for effective control of lawn weeds and will not harm lawn grasses when used according to directions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON LAWNS: For control of Dandelions, Chickweed, Plantains, Clover and the other listed weeds, apply WEED-B-GON M any time weeds are actively growing. Weeds such as wild garlic and wild onions should be sprayed when they appear in late fall and again in early spring.

HOW TO USE: May be applied with an ORTHO Weed Killer Sprayer, ORTHO SPRAY-ETTE™, ORTHO DIAL 'n SPRAY™ Hose-End Sprayer or tank-type sprayer. Refer to table for recommended dilution. If lawn needs watering, water thoroughly before application. Do not water for 48 hours after application. Spray entire lawn, wetting weeds and lawn grasses; do not overspray. Spray when air is calm to avoid spray drift that might injure desirable ornamental plants. Do not apply when temperatures are expected to exceed 85°F within 24 hours following application. Make new dilution for each use.

NEWLY SEEDD LAWNS may be treated after they have been mowed at least 3 times. **BENT, BERMUDA, RED FESCUE, CENTIPEDE AND CARPET GRASSES: GROWING SEASON**— Use one-half recommended rate (2 tsp.) per gal. of water. Make 2 applications 10 days apart. Temporary injury may occur. Do not apply to Dichondra, Lippia, St. Augustine and Clover lawns.

DORMANT SEASON (WINTER): BERMUDA, CENTIPEDE, CARPET GRASSES: Use at regular rate (see Dilution

Dandelions, Chickweed, Plantains, Clover and the other weeds are actively growing. Weeds such as wild garlic and yellow nutsedge appear in late fall and again in early spring.

Ortho Weed-Killer Sprayer, ORTHO SPRAY-ETTER™, ORTHO DIAL™ refer to table for recommended dilution. If lawn needs water for 48 hours after application. Spray entire lawn. Spray when air is calm to avoid spray drift that may occur when temperatures are expected to exceed 85°F. Apply once for each use.

Have been mowed at least 3 times. **BENT, BERMUDE, RED FESCUE SEASON** — Use one-half recommended rate (2 tsp.) Temporary injury may occur. Do not apply to Dichondra,

BENT, BERMUDE, RED FESCUE, CARPET GRASSES: Use at regular rate (see Dilution

Table) and apply when turf is dormant (brown). Reduce rate by one-half (2 tsp.) per gal. water when turf has greened up and is actually growing (see Growing Season).

HARDY WEEDS: For hardy weeds such as sheep sorrel, dock, thistle and morningglory in lawns and other areas, repeat application in 2 to 3 weeks if necessary.

IMPORTANT: Do not use this product for controlling weeds in flower or vegetable beds or around shrubs or ornamental plantings. Do not reseed for 3 to 4 weeks after use.

***Use one-half of this rate for Bent, Bermuda, Red Fescue, Centipede and Carpetgrasses.

Avoid spray contact or drift to susceptible plants as this product may injure flowers, shrubs, garden vegetables, fruit trees and other crops. Coarse sprays are less likely to drift. When ORTHO Sprayer is used and rinsed thoroughly as directed on sprayer jar immediately after applying WEED-B-GON M it can be used to apply insecticides, fungicides and liquid fertilizers to ornamental plants.

TO PREPARE REFILL FOR WEED-B-GON WEED KILLER, EPA REG. NO. 239-2439: Measure 1 Tablespoonful of WEED-B-GON M into the empty container of WEED-B-GON Weed Killer (24 oz. size) and then fill with tap water. Use according to the directions and precautions on the applicator bottle.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not store near feed, foodstuffs, fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides. Store in a cool, dry place, preferably in a locked storage area. Do not store diluted spray.

DISPOSAL: PRODUCT — Partially filled can may be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER** — Do not reuse empty can. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
