# Insect Spray

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Do not use on household pets or humans. Keep children and pets away from treated areas. Do not use on household plants or animals. **STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:** In case of eye contact, wash immediately with soap and water. For skin contact, wash thoroughly with soap and water. Remove and discard contaminated clothing. **Note to Physicians:** Emergency treatment is a light petroleum solvent and may present an aspiration problem. Diazinon is an anticholinesterase inhibitor and symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition develop; atropine is antidotal; 2-PAM may be used if necessary. Do not use alone.

Do not use on fish and wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Keep out of any body of water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. This pesticide or its residues remaining on treated areas. Do not apply when bees are actively foraging. Provide the maximum possible interval between treatment and the next period of bee activity. Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

Do not use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

### USE WITH LABEL PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS AND DIRECTIONS.

For most lawn insects, apply 4 fl. oz. (1/2 cup) in 15 gals. water. For most garden insects, apply 2 fl. oz. in 3 gals. water. Use coarse drenching spray for lawns, soil and surface applications. Thorough coverage is important. Use dosages as indicated for each pest.

**CONTROL LAWN INSECTS:** Ants, Fleas, Sod Webworms, Brown Dog Ticks, White Grubs. Apply 4 fl. oz. in 15 gals. water.

**CONTROL GARDEN INSECTS:** Ants, Cucumber Beetles, Cabbageworms, Codling Moth, Whiteflies. Apply 2 fl. oz. in 3 gals. water.

**CONTROL HOUSE INSECTS:** Ants, Cockroaches, Earwigs, Fleas, Flies, Millipedes, Scorpions, Sowbugs (Pillbugs), Spiders, Termites, Ticks, Wasps. Apply 1/2 fl. oz. in 1 gal. water.

**CONTROL SOIL INSECTS:** Fire Ants—Apply 1 fl. oz. (2 Tbsp.) in a minimum of 1 gal. of water as a drenching spray.

Apply gently to avoid disturbing ants. Reapply as necessary. For best results, apply in late evening hours. Treat new mounds as they appear.

### SHADE TREES

Apply to: Apples (10), Grapes (10), Cherries (10), Strawberries (5). **Note:** Start spraying after blooming.

Apply to: Carrots (10), Peppers (5), Potatoes (35), Onions (10), Cucumbers (7), Cantaloupes (3).

Apply in last application and harvest.

Apply to: Dahlias, Carnations, Gladioli, Pyracantha, Rhododendrons.

Apply to: Elm, Holly, Lilac, Locust, Maple, Pine, Spruce, Sycamore, Willow.

Apply to: Citrus, papaya, pilea, gardenia, and orchids since injury may occur.

**CONTROL GARDEN INSECTS:** Cabbageworms, Codling Moth, Cucumber Beetles, Cutworms, Flea Beetles, Holly Budworms, Mealybugs, Mites, Scale Crawlers, Thrips, Whiteflies—Apply 2 tsp. (1/2 fl. oz.) per gallon of water to wet leaves and branches to dripping point. Repeat if needed.

Apply 1/2 fl. oz. (1/2 cup) in 15 gals. water to cover 500 sq. ft. of soil beneath host plants listed above at 14-16 day intervals as needed.

**FUNGINEX** Rose Disease Control may be mixed with this product when listed on the label. See directions and precautions on both labels.

**CONTROL HOUSE INSECTS:** Ants, Cockroaches, Earwigs, Fleas, Flies, Millipedes, Scorpions, Sowbugs (Pillbugs), Spiders, Termites, Ticks, Wasps. Spray a 5 ft. band of soil around the house next to the foundation to a height of 6 ft. on sills, foundations, porch and patio walls and ceilings, entrance ways, walks, fireplaces and other places where insects can hide. **Do not use in home. Do not treat plants sprayed firewood within 2 weeks following treatment.**

Store in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Recycle empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

Do not use in accordance with directions.


