For use in slurry treaters. Do not allow mixture to stand overnight. Clean out equipment thoroughly between treating operations.


Acid delinted 3 fl. ozs./100 lbs.

Machine delinted 4½ fl. ozs./100 lbs.

RICE: Use 4 to 6 fl. oz. per 100 lbs. of dry seed to help in the control of seed rots and seedling diseases such as Achlya and Pythium. Best results are obtained by treating seeds prior to pre-soaking when planting in flooded fields.


