DIRECTIONS
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
SHAKE, ROLL OR AGITATE CONTAINER TO IMPROVE UNIFORMITY.
For use in slurry treaters. Do not allow mixture to stand over night. Clean out equipment thoroughly between treating operations.
COTTON:
Acid delinted 3 fl. oz. / 100 lbs.
Machine delinted 4½ fl. oz. / 100 lbs.
RICE: use 4 to 6 fl. oz. per 100 lbs. of dry seed to help in the control of seed rots and seedling diseases such as Achlya, Pythium and Helminthosporium. Best results are obtained by treating seeds prior to pre-soaking when planting in flooded fields.

CAUTION: Some people are allergic to this chemical. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Contact may cause irritation and allergic reaction. Persons engaged in treating, bagging or handling treated seed may become sensitized and suffer from allergic contact dermatitis. In case of contact, wash skin and eyes with plenty of water.
