

**HOW TO USE**

**HOME INVADING PESTS** - Ants, Brown dog ticks, Clover mites, Crickets, Fleas, Earwigs, Millipedes, Springtails (Collembola), Sowbugs: Sprinkle a 2 foot band of granules evenly next to the house foundation. Use 8 oz for each 100 sq ft area (2 ft by 50 ft). Repeat application at 3 week intervals if needed.

**SPOT TREATMENT** - Ants: Apply 1 level Tbs over and around each ant hill. Water lightly after application. Digger wasps: Apply 1 level Tbs in and around each ground nest opening. Apply about dusk when the Wasps are not active.

**OVERALL LAWN PROTECTION** - Grass and dichondra lawns: Controls: Chinch bugs, Brown dog ticks, Ants, Sod webworms, (Lawn moths), Cutworms, White grubs (Japanese beetle, European chafer, Southern chafer), Billbugs, Bermudagrass mites, Crickets, Armyworms, Fleas, Leafhoppers, Sowbugs, Millipedes, Springtails.

The lawn should be dry and mowed before application.

White grubs (Japanese Beetle, European chafer, Southern chafer)	Sprinkle 1 lb per 200 sq ft (10 ft by 20 ft) evenly over lawn area	Treat anytime between late July and early October. Water grass thoroughly with at least 1/4 inch of water after application; however, stop watering before puddling occurs. Consult the State Agricultural Extension Service for timing in your area.
Hyperodes weevils	Sprinkle 1 lb per 200 sq ft (10 ft by 20 ft) evenly over lawn area	Treat problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May. Water grass thoroughly with at least 1/4 inch of water after application; however, stop watering before puddling occurs.
Billbugs	Sprinkle 1 lb per 200 sq ft (10 ft by 20 ft) evenly over lawn area	Apply when chewed or brown grass indicates damage. Water grass thoroughly with at least 1/4 inch of water after application; however, stop watering before puddling occurs. If necessary, repeat application in 3 weeks. May be applied up to 4 times per year.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This product is highly toxic to birds, fish, and other wildlife. Birds, especially waterfowl (ducks or geese) feeding or drinking on treated areas may be killed. Because of the migratory habits of certain Atlantic Coast waterfowl, do not apply this product to lawns in Nassau County, New York between November 1 and May 20. Do not exceed maximum permitted label rates. Application rates above those recommended significantly increase potential hazards to birds. Avoid overlapping granules. Follow all watering instructions in the directions for use, however, stop watering before puddling occurs. Do not apply this product to sites occupied by waterfowl, or within 75 ft of any body of water that may attract waterfowl, such as ponds or lakes. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, tidal marshes, and estuaries. Do not apply directly to water. Runoff may be hazardous to fish and other aquatic organisms in neighboring areas.
