It should be applied only to those areas where no plant growth is desired such as driveways, brick walks, gravel pathways, patios, parking areas, along fences, curbs and gutters and cracks in sidewalks. Avoid application over the root system of desirable plants. See **IMPORTANT** below for additional use caution.

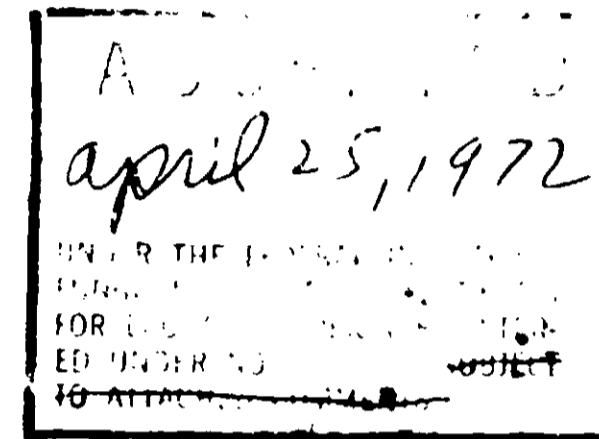

DILUTION TABLE

Amount TRIOX Vegetation Killer to use	Water to Add	Area to Cover
1 Quart	2 1/4 Gallons	75 Sq. Ft.
2 Quarts	4 1/2 Gallons	150 Sq. Ft.
1 Gallon	9 Gallons	300 Sq. Ft.
10 Gallons	90 Gallons	3,000 Sq. Ft.

WHEN TO APPLY: For barren soil and to prevent plant growth, TRIOX Vegetation Killer can be applied anytime, but for best results apply to bare ground or when growth is just starting in the spring. If weeds are taller than 4 to 6 inches, they should be cut down and removed before application. A second application of TRIOX Vegetation Killer may be needed to control deep rooted perennials such as Wild Morning Glory, Bermuda Grass and other weeds. In areas of heavy rainfall, it may be necessary to re-apply TRIOX every 6 to 8 months for effective control.

HOW TO APPLY: Apply with a sprinkling can. If the soil is dry, irrigate before treatment. Refer to the Dilution Table for the recommended rates and size of area to treat. Cover the area to be treated thoroughly.

To prevent growth of weeds under asphalt, driveways, terraces, patios, playgrounds and parking lots, apply TRIOX Vegetation Killer to excavated areas to saturate or drench soil before surface areas are finished.

IMPORTANT: Do not use TRIOX Vegetation Killer on plants when the soil is wet and use it only in dry weather. Do not apply over the root system of trees and shrubs; stay beyond the drip line of desirable ornamentals. Do not flood the ground after applying TRIOX Vegetation Killer. Care should be taken to avoid damage to desirable plants. Do not apply TRIOX to plants that may be damaged by the herbicide or the chemical through the soil.

READ THE LABEL

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

CAUTION: Irritant. Avoid contact with eyes, nose, mouth, throat, and skin. Do not breathe vapor or spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling.
