It is important to note that the results of the K-means clustering analysis are sensitive to the choice of the number of clusters. In this study, the number of clusters was determined based on the elbow method, which involves plotting the within-cluster sum of squares (WCSS) against the number of clusters and identifying the point where the WCSS decreases sharply and then levels off. This method suggests that four clusters is the most appropriate number for this data.
