Most bees and wasps are beneficial, however, when their nests are built too close to windows, doorways, or children's play areas, they may be dangerous and should be killed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR CONTROL OF WASPS AND HORNETS: Apply after dark when all of the insects have returned to the nest. Remove protective cap. Hold container in upright position to spray. Aim valve opening at nest, hold at arms length and depress button, soaking the entire nest with spray. Spray jet will carry for a distance of 6-8 feet. Repeat as necessary. Avoid spraying plant foliage as injury may occur. Do not use as a space spray. For outdoor use only.

OTHER USES - OUTDOORS ONLY: For Control of Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Fleas, Millipedes, Sawflies, and Brown Dog Ticks: Spray infested areas thoroughly including outside surfaces of screen frames, doors, window frames, foundations, patios or other places where insects may enter or harbour. **FOR ANTS:** spray hills and runways. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation. Do not use as a space spray. **FOR SPIDERS - OUTDOORS ONLY:** Spray directly on spiders and treat webs and tracking areas around porches, under eaves, along foundations, similar outdoor areas. Repeat as necessary.

Spray may cause injury to flowers and ornamentals. Before using on easily stained surfaces, test a small spot before giving full treatment.

FIRST AID: If stung by a wasp, apply an icepack to the area of the sting, then apply a paste made with bicarbonate of soda and water. If stung many times or if the reaction is severe, call a physician.

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist. Contact with skin, eyes, or clothing should also be avoided. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid.

Note to Physicians: Emergency Information - call (415) 233-3737. Atropine sulfate is anti-dotal.

Avoid contamination of food, utensils and food preparation areas. Avoid contamination of fish ponds. Remove pets from area before spraying.

DANGER: Extremely flammable, contents under pressure. Do not use near fire, heated surfaces, sparks or flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.
