

15 To help prevent infestation of buildings, treat a band of soil 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the building, also the building foundation to a height of 7 to 3 feet when pests are active and may find entrance.
 500 Do not treat pets with this product.

1 gal. Apply 1 gal. of solution to each individual mound, using a sprinkling can. Thoroughly wet mound and treat a 4 foot diameter circle around the mound. For best results, apply in cool weather or in early morning or late afternoon. Treat new mounds as they appear.

ANTS, TICKS, EARWIGS, CRICKETS, SOWBUGS (PILLBUGS):
 Prevent infestations of buildings, mix 1/2 cup (4 fl. oz.) concentrate in an ORTHO Lawn Sprayer to treat 500 sq. ft. Apply as a band around the building (see chart below). Also treat the building foundation near the entrance. Spray directly on ants, ant trails and places where they can storage areas, outdoor pet resting areas, around dog-

become established in lawns and pet resting areas surrounding buildings. To follow a regular spray program. Spray once a month (May-June) and continuing until late summer (September-October) the severity of these pests. Eliminating weeds around the building places.

Use this product in a hose-end sprayer such as an ORTHO Lawn Sprayer (20" x 25"). Place 3 fl. oz. of the concentrate in the sprayer jar. Attach the sprayer to the jar and use all the spray to evenly cover the lawn a day or two before spraying, and then withhold watering for a slow, even sweeping motion—be sure to cover entire lawn area by spot treating. Also spray shady spots under ornamentals, and avoid soaking young or flowering plants.

Use product only with the attached hose end applicator. Divide the area, apply 3 fl. oz. of READY-SPRAY concentrate for a day or two before spraying. Spray lawn, using a slow, even motion. Do not attempt to control these pests in lawns by spot spraying lightly for a few minutes to move insecticide down into shady spots under ornamentals, shrubs and trees where pets are resting plants. Wash off plant foliage with water after treatment until after the spray has dried. Do not spray animals with this product. Fleas and ticks are indoors on carpets or pet resting areas, use a registered product such as ORTHO Home Pest Insect Control. It is very important that all areas be treated with appropriate labeled products to achieve satisfactory results. Do not use as a source of reinfestation to the entire premises.

Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Avoid contact with children. Store in a locked storage area. Do not store in a place where children can reach it. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper. Rinse thoroughly before discarding.
