ORTHO Liquid Lawn Disease Control gives effective control of common diseases of grass lawns including Brown Patch (*Helminthosporium*), Leaf Spot and Melting Out (*Helminthosporium*), Dollar Spot (*Sclerotinia*), Copper Spot (*Gloeosporangia*), Red Thread (*Corticium*), Curculiana Leaf Spot (*Curculionella*), Gray Leaf Spot (*Piricularia*), and Stem Rust (*Puccinia*) of Bluegrass; also Leaf Spot (*Alternaria*) and Anthracnose in Dichondra lawns (California only).

DIRECTIONS

One day before applying ORTHO Liquid Lawn Disease Control, mow lawn, collect clippings and water if necessary. May be applied with an ORTHO SPRAYETTE or ORTHO Lawn and Garden Sprayer (foliage setting tank type or power sprayer). Shake bottle well before using. For best results when mixing, place a small amount of water in sprayer, add the appropriate amount of ORTHO Liquid Lawn Disease Control, then add water to bring to desired level and agitate gently to combine the solution. Apply spray evenly. Six gallons diluted spray treats 1,000 sq. ft. Agitate occasionally while spraying. Do not water or mow lawn for 48 hours after application. Make new dilution for each use. Do not apply when temperature is above 90°F to prevent slight burning or temporary discoloration of grass lawns. Do not graze treated areas or feed treated plant parts to livestock.

Rates to Mix in 6 Gals. of Water to Cover 1,000 Sq. Ft.

(1) Preventive: 4-8 fl. oz. Curative: 8-16 fl. oz.

(2) Preventive: 8-12 fl. oz. Curative: 12-16 fl. oz.

Note: For 3 gal. rate, cut above rates in half and apply to cover 500 sq. ft.

Preventive Program: Begin applications when disease threatens or when conditions favor disease development. During periods of very wet or damp weather, apply every 7 days. Use lower rates when disease conditions are light to moderate; higher indicated rates when conditions are severe.

Curative Program: If disease is already established, use a curative rate. Higher indicated rates should be applied under severe conditions. Make at least 3 successive applications at 7 day intervals. Continue treatments using PREVENTIVE PROGRAM until lawn has recovered.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs. Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Do not reuse empty container. Wash container and put in trash collection.

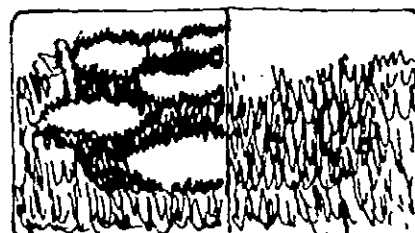
