ORTHO Liquid Lawn Disease Control gives effective control of common diseases of grass lawns including: Brown Patch (*Rhizoctonia*), Helminthosporium Leaf Spot and Melting Out (*Helminthosporium*), Dollar Spot (*Sclerotinia*), Copper Spot (*Gloeosporangium*), Red Thread (*Coronum*), Yellow Leaf Spot (*Curvularia*), Gray Leaf Spot (*Pyricularia*), Stem Rust (*Puccinia*), Bluegrass Yellow Leaf Spot (*Alternaria*) and Anthracnose in Dichondra lawns (all forms only).

DIRECTIONS

One day before applying ORTHO Liquid Lawn Disease Control, mow lawn, collect clippings and water if necessary. May be applied with an ORTHO SPRAYETTE or ORTHO Lawn and Garden Sprayer (hose attachment type) or power sprayer. Shake bottle well before using. For best results, when mowing, place a small amount of water in sprayer and the appropriate amount of ORTHO Liquid Lawn Disease Control, then add water to fill to desired level and agitate gently to uniformly mix the solution. Apply sprayer evenly. 5 gallons diluted spray treats 1,000 sq. ft. Apply evenly as early as possible. Do not water lawn for 48 hours after application. Mow lawn 2-3 days after application. Do not apply when temperature is above 90°F. Do not apply if rain is expected within 24 hours. Do not apply if rain is expected within 24 hours.

IMPORTANT: ORTHO Liquid Lawn Disease Control is effective on a wide range of diseases. However, proper identification of the lawn disease is essential for control. Take a specimen of the disease to a professional garden center for identification. For more information, see the back of this label.

FOR ESTABLISHED LISTED DISEASES AND SEVERE CONDITIONS: Apply 12 fl. oz. (3/4 cup) in 6 gallons of water to cover 1,000 sq. ft. During periods of heavy wet or damp weather, make 15-20 applications at 7-10 day intervals. Control treatment to prevent further disease development.

FOR LIGHT DISEASE INCIDENCE AND MILD CONDITIONS: Apply 8 fl. oz. (2/3 cup) in 6 gallons of water to cover 1,000 sq. ft. Apply at a 10-16 day interval depending on severity of disease and control. After treatment, disease development will be reduced. **NOTE:** For 500 sq. ft. lawn, use at the rate of 1 qt. of product in 3 gallons of water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
