*Spray 2-3 times about 7-10 days apart to kill these harder-to-kill pests. Additional sprays may be needed if plants become reinfested.

When to Apply — Spray at first sign of pests, before infestation is heavy. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals when insect populations occur. Spray in the morning when air is still — not in heat of mid-day or in bright sun. Do not apply to wilted plants.

How to Apply — Hold can in upright position approximately 18" from plant. Apply as a light dry spray covering both upper and lower leaf surfaces. To spray under leaves, turn can upside down and release spray. Note: Holding aerosol too close to foliage may result in overwetting and damage to tender foliage.

INDOORS—Kills the Following Insect Pests on House Plants as Listed.

Whitefly*	Geranium, Fuchsia, Mirror Plant, Blood Flower, Butterflyweed, Poinsettia

*Spray 2-3 times about 7-10 days apart to kill these harder-to-kill pests. Additional sprays may be needed if plants become reinfested.

When to Apply—Spray at first sign of pests, before infestation is heavy. Repeat if necessary. Do not apply more frequently than the 7 day interval noted above. Do not apply to wilted plants or to plants that are in direct sunlight. Plants may be sprayed indoors.

How to Apply
Hold can approximately 18" from plant. Apply as a light spray, in short bursts, covering both upper and lower leaf surfaces. Do not spray towards face, or put face in mist cloud.

NOTE: Holding aerosol too close to foliage may result in overwetting and damage to tender foliage. Avoid direct spraying of plastic pots, asbestos tile, vinyl tile floors or latex painted walls as etching or staining may occur.

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
