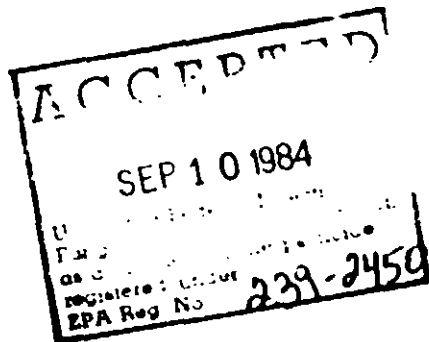

**WEED CONTROL IN DRY-SEEDED MISSISSIPPI AND ARKANSAS.**

**Application Directions—For Dry Seeded Mississippi and Arkansas**

**Late Preemergence Application (Pre-planting)** — For control of Wild Rice (Leptochloa spp.) prior to rice emergence, apply BOLERO 8 EC after planting of the rice. Apply after soils have been seeded to well prepared seedbeds free of weeds at time of application. Do not apply BOLERO 8 EC to cracked soil after emergence treatment to cracked soil.

**Early Postemergence Application** — Apply 4 pts of BOLERO 8 EC to rice after emergence, but not later than fully emerged at time of application.

Do not apply BOLERO 8 EC to rice after emergence. Do not apply BOLERO 8 EC to rice after emergence.

**Water Management**—After application, it is necessary to prevent crusting of the soil. Do not be flooded as soon as the rice has emerged.

**Application Equipment**  
**Aircraft** Apply BOLERO 8 EC to rice at 10 gals per acre.

**Ground Sprayers** Apply in 10 gals per acre.

**Precautions** Do not apply more than 4 times per year. Do not plant rice within 6 months of last application. Do not use in farming of crayfish, wild rice, or other fish ponds. In Texas and other states where the agricultural practice of draining rice fields to irrigate other crops is common, do not apply BOLERO 8 EC to rice fields to be irrigated.

Application to stressed rice can result in growth inhibition, delayed maturation, and other factors include but are not limited to temperatures below 65° F., or above 90° F., high soil content, low soil fertility, above field capacity while rice is in the field, poor field drainage or other conditions.
