HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER

Keep out of reach of children and pets. Do not use on food crops. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Wash thoroughly with soap and water if contact occurs.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of poisoning, call your doctor or poison control center. If swallowed, give 1-2 glasses of water. If inhaled, get fresh air. If on skin, wash with soap and water. If in eyes, flush with water for 15 minutes.

Store in a cool, dry place. Do not use if the container is damaged. Do not use if the contents are discolored or if the odor is strong. Do not store diluted spray. Do not store diluted spray in a container that was previously used for another pesticide.
