DIRECTIONS

SHAKE THOROUGHLY BEFORE USE

When to Apply: Spray thoroughly on all parts of the plant, including the undersides of leaves. Repeat as necessary. Do not apply more frequently than every 7 days. Do not spray if there is rain or water standing on the plants. Do not spray if the temperature is below 50°F or above 90°F. Do not spray if the wind is blowing. Do not spray if the plants are stressed or if they are in bloom.

How to Apply: Mix 1/2 ounce of ORTHO House Plant Insect Killer with 1 gallon of water. Spray thoroughly on all parts of the plant, including the undersides of leaves. Repeat as necessary.
