*On these harder-to-kill pests, repeat applications 1 to 2 more times at 7 to 10 day intervals after the initial treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate in a plastic bottle or other containers. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Store in a cool, dry place, preferably in a locked storage area.

DISPOSAL: PRODUCT in this container may be disposed of by placing in a plastic bag and burying in several layers of newspaper in a trash can. **CONTAINER:** Do not reuse empty bottle. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.

For 24 Fl. oz. size

"How to Apply - Fold back protective hinged tab exposing nozzle. Snap in place on sprayer top. Hold container about 12 inches from plant and pump with the nozzle directed at the pests on both sides of the leaves. Avoid over wetting foliage. Avoid spraying blossoms as discoloration may occur."

Kills the following pests on most house plants including the examples listed below.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: For storage, reseal by replacing tab closure over spray nozzle. Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of feed and food stuffs. Store in a cool, dry place preferably in a locked storage area. Disposal: Product - Partially filled bottles may be disposed by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Container - Do not reuse empty bottle. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.


The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) is acceptable provided that you:
