DIRECTIONS

SHAKE THOROUGHLY BEFORE USE.

When to Apply—Spray at first signs of insects, before infestation is heavy. Repeat as necessary. Do not apply more frequently than every 7 days. Do not apply to wilted or water stressed plants or plants that are in direct sunlight. For harder-to-control pests as noted below, 2 to 3 applications at 7 to 10 day intervals may be necessary.

For 8 Fl. oz. size

How to Apply—Hold container 6" to 8" from the plant and pump with the nozzle directed at the pests on the leaves. Spray to completely cover insects on upper and lower leaf surfaces. Avoid overwetting foliage. Plants may be sprayed indoors. Avoid spraying blossoms as discoloration may occur.

For 24 Fl. oz. size

How to Apply—Fold back protective hinged tab exposing nozzle. Snap in place on sprayer top. Adjust spray nozzle to give a mist spray. Hold container about 12 inches from plant and pump with the nozzle directed at the pests on both sides of the leaves. Avoid overwetting foliage. Avoid spraying blossoms as discoloration may occur.
