*Spray 2 to 3 times 7 to 10 days apart to kill these harder-to-kill pests. Additional sprays may be needed if plants become reinfested.

WHEN TO APPLY: For insect and Disease Prevention and Control - Spray weekly, starting before disease appears or at first signs of pests. Repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals. Spray in the morning not in the heat of midday. Do not apply to wilted plants.
