FRUIT TREES, SHADE TREES AND LARGE ORNAMENTALS. Apply to the soil around the base of the plant.

FLOWER AND BEDDING PLANTS. Apply to the soil around the base of the plant.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry place. Do not use if the container is damaged.
