

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS
